

CODE ENFORCEMENT

The Code Enforcement Officer resolves complaints of ordinance violations and seeks out additional violations throughout the City of La Grange. This involves educating the citizens about the ordinances and helping them to become compliant. In most instances the majority of all violations are resolved immediately.

There have been 722 ordinance violations/ complaints from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015. These are broken down into the following categories:

- Dangerous trees or stacks..... 4
- Illegal signage (includes snipe signs).....321
- Mud on street/road..... 3
- Obstruction of streets, sidewalks, and drainage.... 6
- Storage of junk/scrap metal or motor vehicles..... 10
- Accumulation of rubbish..... 14
- Weeds and grass taller than 12 inches..... 32
- Abandoned vehicles..... 9
- Barking dogs..... 2
- Unsafe buildings..... 3
- Stop Work Orders issued..... 41
- Prohibited lighting..... 4
- No Business License.....217
- Large item garbage complaints..... 5
- Sidewalks needing repair..... 0
- Road work not being completed..... 0
- Parking violations..... 6
- Courtesy notices..... 22
- Historic Preservation complaint..... 23

This year \$337,498.06 was collected in fees for business licenses.
This year 2,136,822.99 was collected for Compensation Tax.
